Ajyal International School – Al Falah Smoke-Free Environment Policy

1. Purpose

Ajyal International School – Al Falah is committed to providing a safe, healthy, and supportive learning environment for all students, staff, and visitors. In alignment with ADEK's *Guide to Drugs**Prevention in the School Environment, this policy establishes a strict smoke-free standard across all school premises and transportation services.

2. Policy Statement

The school is a **100% smoke-free zone**. Smoking, vaping, or the use of any tobacco or nicotine products is **strictly prohibited** in all areas of the school campus and on all school buses. This rule applies to:

- All staff, students, parents, and visitors.
- School drivers, cleaners, contractors, and external service providers.

No-smoking signage is clearly displayed at every entrance, in staff areas, and in parking zones to reinforce awareness and compliance.

3. Scope

This policy applies to:

- All school buildings, classrooms, playgrounds, and facilities.
- Parking areas, walkways, and outdoor spaces within the school grounds.
- All school-owned or leased vehicles, including buses used for student transport and school events.

4. Responsibilities

- All staff are expected to model positive behavior and ensure compliance within their areas.
- The HSE Officer and HR Department are responsible for monitoring adherence to this policy and maintaining related documentation.





- Bus supervisors and drivers must ensure that buses remain smoke-free at all times.
- Visitors and parents are expected to comply with this policy during all visits and events on school property.

5. Implementation Measures

- "No Smoking" and "No Vaping" signs are installed in all designated areas.
- The policy is included in the Staff Code of Conduct and Parent Handbook.
- All staff, drivers, and cleaners must sign a **No-Smoking Declaration** confirming their commitment to this policy.
- Violations of this policy will result in disciplinary action as per school and ADEK regulations.

6. Review

This policy will be reviewed annually by the Health & Safety Committee to ensure ongoing compliance with ADEK regulations and to promote a safe, smoke-free school environment for all.
